Each year University Hall seeks to support rural Western Australian students in their move to study at The University of Western Australia (UWA) by offering two Ralph Pervan Scholarships. The scholarships guarantee a place in University Hall for the first academic year and will assist in covering up to 17 weeks of rent in second semester.

Any student completing Year 12 at a secondary school in rural WA and seeking admission to a course at UWA in the following year, may apply for the award of one of the scholarships.

"The Ralph Pervan Scholarship is free board for up to seventeen weeks. It's been a massive help in terms of finances for my parents and I, so it's great," says Sneha Mishra, 2016 Scholarship Recipient.
