



University Club Bursaries 2017

Applications close Friday February 10th 2017

The University Club of Western Australia provides an annual bursary for the benefit of University Hall students. The bursaries are awarded on the basis of demonstrated need, potential and achievement.

The bursaries are administered with the following guidelines:

1. Four bursaries, each worth \$5,000, will be awarded
2. Bursaries are awarded as one off payments. Previous awardees may not apply.
3. Applications are open to all current University Hall residents (other than those as at #2) and new residents who have received and accepted a 2017 Offer of Accommodation at University Hall.
4. Bursaries will be awarded at the commencement of semester one and bursary amounts will be credited against the recipients account with the Hall.
5. Bursaries will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal and Deputy Principal.

Application Process

Please complete the attached application form providing the information detailed below.

Applications should be submitted to the Principal via reslife@unihall.uwa.edu.au with the subject line 'CONFIDENTIAL: University Club Bursary Application'.

1. A detailed breakdown (actual dollar amounts) of:
 - *Your weekly income including paid employment and other financial support that you receive (e.g. income from parents, Centrelink, bursaries or other).*
 - *Your weekly expenses including rent, car/parking, food, personal items.*

Note: if your income is less than your rent expenses, you need to include how you are paying for these currently (e.g. do you have savings? Do you have family support?)

2. Academic studies, with a copy of your academic records and enrolment downloaded from Student Connect. A screenshot copy is adequate. New residents who have not yet commenced studies at UWA are asked to provide their most recent school or university results.
3. Contributions and achievements that you have made either in the Hall, the broader community and/or at the University.

If appropriate, applicants may attach documentation to support their application. Applications which do not include the above information will not be considered. It is the responsibility of applicants to show clearly how they meet the criteria of demonstrated need, potential and achievement.




