ROLE STATEMENT

As a University Hall (UniHall) Ambassador volunteer you will represent UniHall, both on and off campus, to future students, their parents and distinguished guests. Your primary role is to assist the UniHall Marketing and Communications Officer with the promotion of residential life. RESPONSIBILITIES

A range of opportunities are available for you to take ownership of:

- **UniHall Tours and Events**
All UniHall Ambassadors showcase the community at the Hall to visitors by leading tours of the Hall's rooms and facilities and by representing the Hall at events by networking and sharing your experiences living on campus.
- **Expos and Secondary School Visits**
All UniHall Ambassadors attend expos and secondary school visits with the aim of providing peer-to-peer advice to future students and their parents based on your personal experiences living at the Hall.
- **UWA Open Day**
All UniHall Ambassadors take part in Open Day activities by leading tours, sharing your UniHall experiences with visitors and assisting with activity set up and pack down.
- **Event Photography**
Attend UniHall events to capture experiences for high quality albums.
- **Designers**
Create material for internal communications in line with the UniHall style guide.
- **Reporters**
Attend UniHall events and share your student experiences through news stories.
- **U Belong Project**
Become part of a team to prepare the pre-communications (print and digital) for new residents moving into the Hall.
- **Social Media Leaders**
Showcase the UniHall community across the Facebook and Instagram channels.
